

THE TRINITY PRAYER

“The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen.” II Corinthians 13:14 NKJV

PART 1: THE LOVE OF GOD THE FATHER

“Love” in Hebrew is “hesed.” The most important phrase in Old Testament prayer and worship was “His love (hesed) endures forever.”

His covenant love is an unconditional love. It is the love of a superior for an inferior. It is merciful love that is loyal and strong. It is in most of the psalms, and it is coupled together in many verses with the Hebrew word “emet” (faithfulness). God’s love for us is seen in His divine Name given to Moses in Exodus 34:6-8.

The first part of the Trinity Prayer is to receive and enjoy God’s immense hesed love for you. His hesed is seen in the five primary divine names in Psalm 103:1-5: salvation, healing, protection, in-filling, and blessings.

PART 2: THE GRACE OF JESUS CHRIST

God’s love (hesed) is in the heavens. It fills the entire universe (Psalm 108:4). It needed grace to come into this corrupted earth we live in.

“And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.”

John 1:14 ESV

Jesus is God’s grace incarnate. (John 1:16 ESV: “From His fullness we have all received, grace upon grace”).

PART 2: THE GRACE OF JESUS CHRIST: CONT.

Every day we should walk with Christ in our prayer time for each step of His grace:

1. His grace to be led by the Spirit into the wilderness: Spirit-led
2. His grace to wash the feet of His disciples: servanthood
3. His grace to agonize three hours in Gethsemane: prayer & long suffering
4. His grace to receive the crown of thorns and be spit upon by 600 soldiers: focus on His mission
5. His grace to be buried for three days, defeat all powers of darkness, and rise triumphant: Kingdom Power!
6. His grace to intercede continually for us at the right hand of the Father (Hebrews 7:25): day to day grace

PART 3: THE FELLOWSHIP OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

After RECEIVING the love of the Father and the grace of Jesus Christ, we should INVITE the Holy Spirit to a time of fellowship and intimate friendship.

SURRENDER the parts of your body to Him (eyes, ears, hands, feet, mouth).
TAKE CAPTIVE the thoughts of your mind to Him (pride, greed, and lust).
RECEIVE the fruit of the Spirit into your Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23).

RELIGHT the seven lamps of the Holy Spirit in your spirit (Isaiah 11:2). Every day we need fresh oil to stir up the gifts that are within us (2 Timothy 1:6).

1. The Lamp Of Freedom (INTIMACY)
2. The Lamp Of Wisdom (ORDER)
3. The Lamp Of Understanding (CLARITY)
4. The Lamp Of Counsel (DECISIONS)
5. The Lamp Of Might (AUTHORITY)
6. The Lamp Of Knowledge (REVELATION)
7. The Lamp Of The Fear Of The Lord (INTEGRITY)
